

Tigers at War is a remarkable story of the infantry of the Princess of Wales's Royal Regiment, the Tiger by nickname, who, since the end of the Cold War and fall of the Iron Curtain, have served on the front line in Northern Ireland, the Balkans, Iraq and Afghanistan, as well as the many small wars and brush fires across Africa, Asia and Europe. The Regiment's unstinting and courageous service around the globe reflects Britain's political and military engagement on the world stage over the last quarter-century, and the Tigers emerged from the Second Gulf War (2003-09) with the distinction of having won more gallantry decorations for valour than any other regiment in the British Army.
